

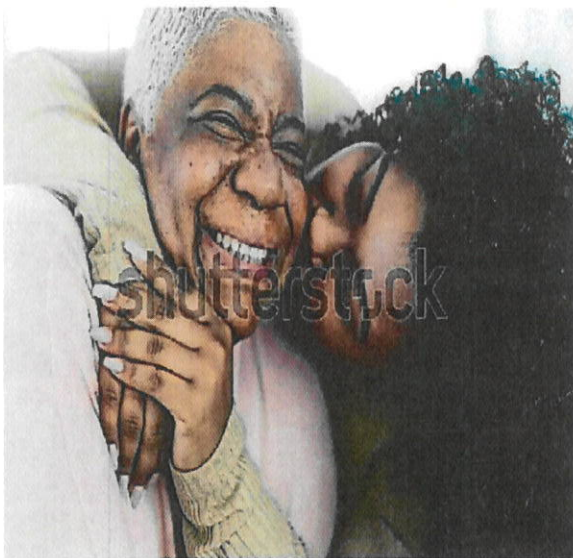

## Senior Supportive Services (SSS)

**Services To Assist Seniors Facing Health and/or Economic Difficulty:**

- Through a referral process, SSS provides assistance and advocacy with housing, and other services seniors may need.
- Contactless home visits are conducted to monitor the seniors well being and determine the level of need for services through a assessments of needs.
- Through a referral process, SSS provides Life Line, PSE&G, Medicaid, assistance with the application process, etc.
- We provide telephone reassurance. Through regular phone calls, we ensure the safety and well being of seniors living alone.
- Home Based Supportive Services provide in home assistance & personal care for the frail , disabled and elderly.
- Programs provide up to date information on Covid 19 testing and referrals.

## National Family Care Givers Program

National Family Care Givers program primary function is to provide relief to the Caregiver who has been caring for a elderly person. The program provides an array of services to the senior they are responsible of caring for, through in-home assistance and support .
